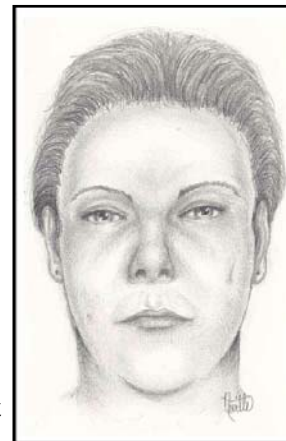


Attention: Academy of General Dentistry; and Homicide, Missing Persons, and Crime Analysis Units

On January 25th, 1986, a partially-clothed female body was discovered along I-70 in rural Saline County, Kansas. All attempts to identify this female have been unsuccessful.

The victim is described as a white female about 25-30 years old, 5'5", weighing 125 pounds, having brown hair with frosted highlights, and blue/gray colored eyes. The body had notable scars to include: an appendectomy scar; a 1" scar on the jawbone to the left of the chin; a ¾" scar from the jawbone to below the left cheek area; and a circular-shaped ¾" scar on the right knee. Stretch marks were visible on the abdomen.



A complete dental examination of the victim was conducted by Dr. John Adams, D.D.S., on February 4, 1986. Additional dental information: Recent (6 to 8 weeks prior to discovery) extraction of tooth #3; root canal therapy on tooth #14 with broken reamer in M B root of this tooth 2-3 mm long at apex of root; both upper first premolars were extracted and orthodontics done to close the spaces; a retained primary 2nd molar and no #20; #29 rotated 90 degrees; all fillings were Amalgam.
